# ALLIGATOR SENS.IT RS TPMS NOW COVERS 2017-2019 KARMA REVERO

Alligator sens.it RS universal TPMS sensors now cover the 2017-2019 Karma Revero. The vehicle is part of a recent trend in TPMS system design for OE manufactures - automatic learning.

If no scan tool is available for manual sensor ID registration, then simply park the car for 20 minutes, and drive it until the tire pressures update in the dash display.

Using sensors that have an auto-learning feature is especially helpful for DIYers that install wheels themselves but don't have access to a scan tool for new sensor ID registration and for wheel shops that rely on the end-users to handle the TPMS learning process.

The sensor also supports location detection, so when rotating tires, there's no need to reset the system manually - simply follow the same procedure as auto-learning and the display will show the new locations on the dash after driving for a few minutes.

Shops that stock Alligator sens.it RS sensors are utilizing TPMS units that support the full range of OEM features, which makes the techs' jobs easier, reduces unnecessary downtime in the bays for TPMS learning or sensor issues, helps the business' bottom line, and keeps customers happy and coming back.
